TASK: Replace Guide Bracket or Shorten Chain on Indoor or Outdoor Shades with Continuous Loop

Use If/When: The shade has a broken chain guide or control chain needs shortened.

Tools Needed: Screwdriver, Scissors

1. Remove the chain guide at the bottom of the chain loop.



OR



2. Pull apart connector bead.



OR



3. For chain shortening (plastic chain ONLY), cut chain between <u>connector bead</u> and <u>stop bead</u>.

For chain guide replacement, proceed to step 5.

Note: For steel chain shortening, replace with assembled clutch. Reference clutch replacement troubleshooting document



4. Pull chain through chain guide and reassemble chain.
